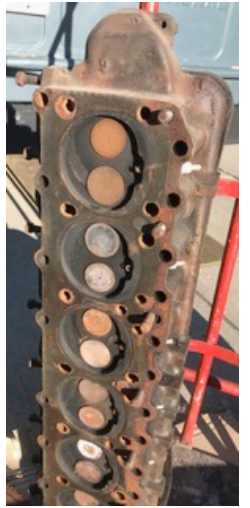

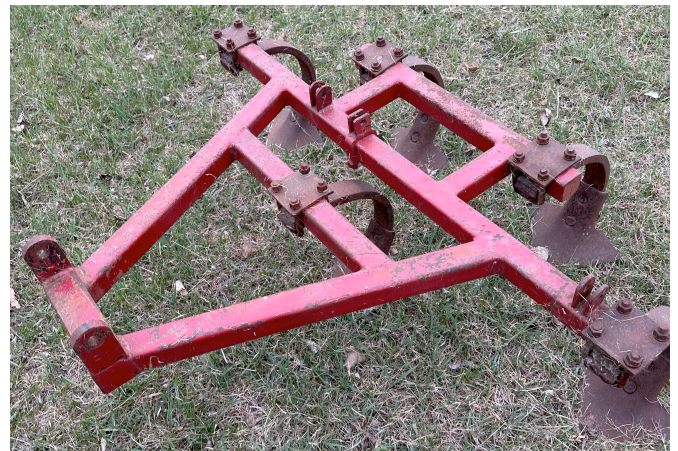

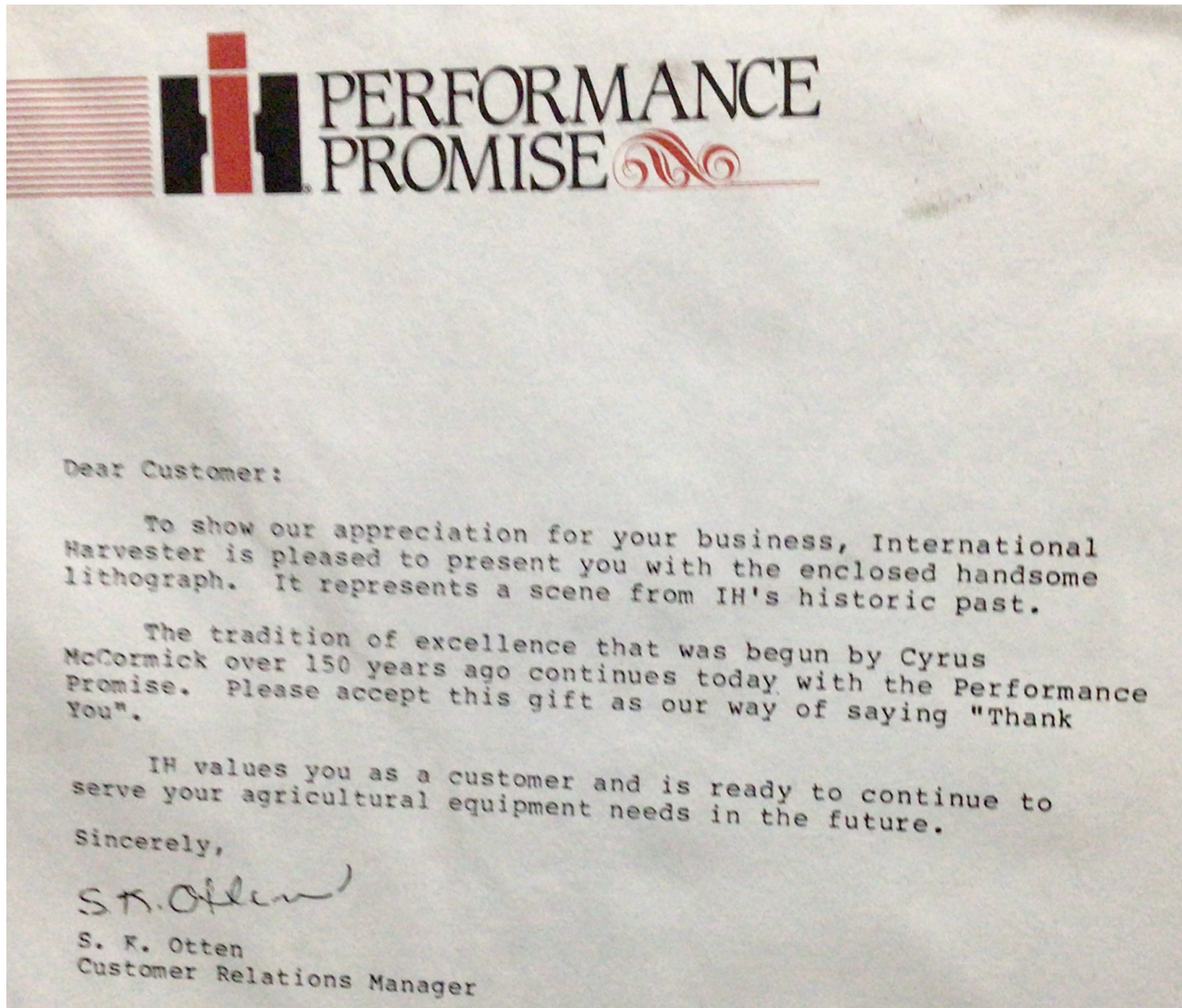

# McCormickland

Several people in Vegreville were curious about a small piece of land north of the Co-op that has a collection of International and McCormick tractors, equipment, combines, trucks, and more. Darcy Lencewich started collecting these machines in May of 2009 when the obsession started with a W4 McCormick tractor. The machinery is from the late 40s, 50s, and 60s. The newest is a 1966

model 1206 International.

The combines are from the early 70s. Darcy grew up on a farm southeast of Vegreville in Lavoy, which he believes has something to do with his passion for collecting this equipment. He is a mechanic by trade now and lives in Vegreville. "These W4 and W6 tractors and machinery were like the ones I grew up with on the farm. You can take the boy out of the farm, but you can't take the farm out of the boy. I don't own any land, except this 1/2 acre of a farm I

purchased in 2020, I have called "McCormickland". The closest I might come to owning a farm at all. I also cut and split firewood here.

Tractors are displayed at the Vegreville Father's Day Show and Shine, at tractor pulls, field work at the Vegreville Corn Maze, when I am parading in towns, and when plowing for certain farmers."

Darcy closed by saying the equipment in the past was simpler, with less technology, and easier to operate, in his opinion.

## MEMBER PROFILE - Darcy Lencevich

*Editor comment - I spotted this tractor at the recent Leduc West Antique Society show July 27/13.*



This tractor is a 1954 Super W6 TA. It has a belt pulley, live power take off, & torque amplifier. Back as Black was my inspiration to do something out of the norm. Something that would just wow them. It all started in October 2011 with what looked as nothing more than a tractor, rusted from the rain, flat tires, no hood or cylinder head, you know the routine. After about a year & half later of winter weekends, days off & late evenings, on June 2013 the completion of what I feel is the only Black IH tractor in Alberta came to life. The engine is bored out & stroked with 350 cubic in displacement. A stroker kit was I purchased from Denny's carb shop in Fletcher Ohio. Carb, distributor, camshaft, lifters were also modified at Dennys carb shop. The engine clutch disc, pressure plate, TA clutch disc & pressure plate are heavy duty pieces from Hy-Capacity from Westlock Tractor Parts. \$1,000.00 of chrome, including headlights, dustcaps, muffler, acorn nuts, linkages, & ampmeter cover. The battery & charging system is 12 volts, negative ground, and chrome 60 amp alternator. I'm proud of restoring my SW6TA "BACK AS BLACK" tractor that I rescued from that old farmer who may have had it scrapped out. My plans are to parade, show & tractor pull with this Black Beauty. McCormick never painted their tractors black, but in 2013 Darcy Lencevich of Vegreville Alberta sure as hell did....! I also have others that I plan on restoring, one day. Darcy.

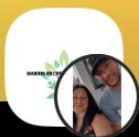

## 1982 INTERNATIONAL 1750 CARGOSTAR GETS A NEW LIFE!

For many years, I had been toying with the idea of getting a flat deck truck to haul my bigger tractors to shows and tractor pulls. I knew a friend of mine had this International 1750 Cargostar.

It was originally a fire truck but he was using it as a water tanker. When he wanted to sell it I bought the truck and a used flat deck.



I put the two together and had some logs milled to replace the rotting deck. The truck has a DT466 engine with a 5 speed transmission and a two speed rear end. It has air brakes. The truck has 36,000 original kilometres.

So far it has been very dependable. I have enjoyed using it and I am glad that I finally decided to make it happen.

## RARE INTERNATIONAL I-14 SURVIVOR!

I had heard about this International I-14 for quite some time. The previous owner was from Oregon.

He used to come into the place where I work as a service technician - Island Tractor. He always wanted me to buy it. Eventually he moved to Vancouver Island and brought his collection with him. He passed away about 5 years later.

The executor of his estate was friends with a friend of mine. A deal was done and the tractor became mine about 10 years ago. The tractor just sat until this winter when my son wanted to pull it out and work on it. We had to fix up a magneto, find a fuel pump and get it working. We also cleaned the fuel tank, mounted the radiator and got it running. Then we repaired the rotten fenders and I made a new exhaust system.



From what I can tell the I-14 is a fairly rare tractor. It has a few interesting features like having no governor, large rear cast wheels with truck sized brake drums built into the wheels and heavy front wheels. We haven't painted the tractor yet. For now we will leave it as is. This year we will take it to a couple of local shows and see how it performs.
