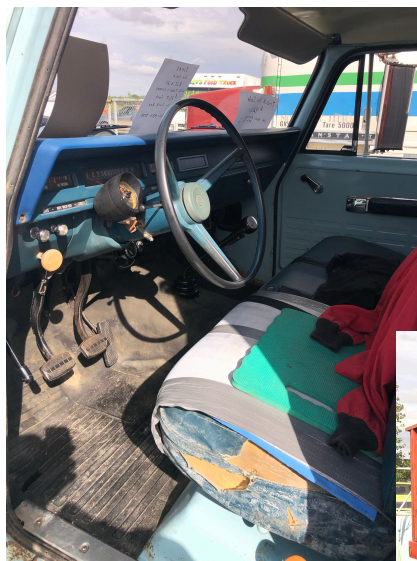

August 16, 2025

- Marty read the minutes from our 2024 Annual Meeting. Steve G. motioned that the minutes be accepted as read Bernie Y. seconded - carried.
- Presidents Report
  - Colleen thanked all who helped to make this years' show in Neilburg a success.
  - Colleen said the Chapter 38 booth at Ag in Motion in Langham was a big success. Memorabilia sales were around \$1,000 each day and a few new memberships were sold. She thanked Larry U. and Jason W. for the IH display items they brought to the show.
  - Colleen thanked Chris and the rest of the Neilburg Historical Club for their hospitality and support as host partner for this show. She is very pleased with day 1 of the show and is looking forward to Sunday.
- Financial Report – Donna reviewed the Financial Statement for 2024.

Claude R. motioned that the Financials be accepted, Blair L. seconded – carried.

- Membership Secretary Report
  - Donna reported that we currently have 141 primary members and we have 83 family memberships. To date, this year, we have also received \$875 in donations.
- Newsletter Report
  - Bernie appealed to the general membership to submit content or suggestions for content. Tell us what restoration projects you are working on in your shop. Articles for the next Newsletter need to be submitted by Aug. 22nd.
- Social Media Report
  - Sera has resigned her position. If you or someone you know would like to take on this responsibility, please contact Colleen U.
- Show Update 2026
  - Jared N. spoke on behalf of the LA Vintage Machinery Club at Lacombe, AB. He is promoting a mid July 2026 Chapter 38 Show on the Agricultural Society grounds. There is a lot of interest by members of the LA Vintage club to partner with Chapter 38. We would have full access to the grounds

and all facilities. The only limiting factor may be the availability of enough volunteers to run all the equipment. Threshing can certainly be part of the show – we would just need to request that bundles be ordered this fall. Chapter 38 would have access to the LA Society clubhouse. Kitchen staff is willing to work the show – including breakfast both days.

- Colleen thanked Jared for his presentation. Executive will review and vote on this proposal.
- Elections
